- This is Ian Tyson's first solo album. Originally recorded in 1973 for A&M Records, it finally joins the Stony Plain catalog - where all his solo albums now live.
- This budget price CD is a sterling collection of great songs and inspired singing, and was the foundation stone of a remarkable career that grows with each new release.
- Ol' Eon was cut while Ian was hosting a weekly country music program for CTV (first called Nashville North and later the Ian Tyson Show), and a number of songs had been "road tested" on the show. The Opening song *Some Kind of Fool* was the Programs signature tune.
- Ian Tyson's Canadian sales exceed 500,000 units including two Gold and One Platinum Award.
- Ian Tyson is a member of the Juno and the Canadian Country Music Hall of Fame.
